I am pleased to announce that, today, we completed the process for WGL Holdings, Inc. to combine operations with AltaGas Ltd. This day marks the culmination of over one year of hard work to earn all the regulatory approvals required for this acquisition. Now that the agreement is final, Washington Gas, WGL Energy Services, WGL Energy Systems, WGL Midstream and Hampshire Gas have become wholly owned subsidiaries of AltaGas.

Washington Gas will continue to provide clean, safe and reliable natural gas to our more than 1.1 million customers across the District of Columbia, Maryland and Virginia. The Washington Gas name will remain and, just as importantly, so will our dedicated workforce of employees, as we continue to serve our customers as we have done for 170 years. Our customers will pay their bills the same way, reach us at the same telephone numbers and encounter our friendly staff in all of our walk-in centers. Simply put, Washington Gas remains Washington Gas.

Our other entities—WGL Energy Services, WGL Energy Systems, WGL Midstream and Hampshire Gas—also will maintain their customer relationships and their local operations.

As Washington Gas and WGL become part of a larger, more broad-based business that spans the United States and Canada, we are excited about the growth opportunity that this brings, for our company and for the Washington, D.C., metropolitan region. As we went through the regulatory process to complete this combination, AltaGas made a number of commitments across all of Washington Gas' service territories. Rate credits for residential and non-residential customers in Maryland and Washington, D.C; increased investment in charitable giving; investment in workforce development; excavator education and training; increased supplier diversity spend; and more energy assistance for low-income customers are all a part of these commitments that we have made and will fulfill. In addition, we are committed to helping all jurisdictions work toward a cleaner energy future.

Finally, I will be retiring as CEO of WGL. Going forward, Washington Gas will be expertly managed with Adrian Chapman assuming the role of President and CEO of Washington Gas. Adrian has spent more than 35 years with Washington Gas, most recently as President and

Chief Operating Officer. His wisdom, judgment and expertise in the energy industry cannot be overstated and Washington Gas can look forward to a bright future under his leadership.
