



MARYLAND ENERGY ASSISTANCE

EMPOWER LOW INCOME ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAM (LIEEP)

This program provides home weatherization services – such as weather-stripping, caulking, plastic window covering and gas furnace tune-up and replacement – at no cost to eligible families. MARYLAND ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MEAP):

MEAP, federally funded through the **Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)**, assists customers in paying their winter heating bills. Grants are based on family size, income and the type of fuel used for heating. Applicants are eligible to apply for the MEAP program only once each program year, July 1 - May 31.

UTILITY SERVICE PROTECTION PROGRAM (USPP):

The **USPP** begins the first week of November and is available to residential customers who are eligible for MEAP aid. With USPP, customers receive a natural gas bill for the same amount each month throughout the year.

WASHINGTON AREA FUEL FUND (WAFF)

Founded by Washington Gas and administered by The Salvation Army, WAFF helps families who do not qualify for, or who have exhausted, government energy assistance.

WAFF provides funds for **all types of fuel** to heat families' homes during the winter heating season. Washington Gas pays the administrative fees of the fund so 100% of WAFF contributions go to those in need. WAFF assistance is available Jan. 1 - May 31.
